108 Proposed Parking Restriction – Trem Yr Afon, Llandudno Junction

Councillors discussed the proposal to introduce parking restrictions in Trem Yr Afon to prevent obstruction

RESOLVED that the proposal is supported in principle, provided that it is not detrimental to the residents of Trem Yr Afon. Conwy County Borough Council are asked to ensure that the residents have been consulted.

109 Litter in Conwy

Councillors discussed the issue of litter in the community. Concern was expressed about the litter bins in Conwy town overflowing following the Christmas Eve event and it was felt that this, and the increase in litter has been caused by the increasing number of food outlets allowing takeaways. Councillors discussed providing extra bins on Christmas Eve and maybe shopkeepers could provide their own bins outside their premises

Councillors discussed issues with litter over the Christmas period as a result of fewer collections of recycling. The major concern was that some of this was food which could attract vermin. Councillors said that Conwy County Borough Council had reduced the number of collections as they believed the area would be quiet but there were still a large number of tourists around. Councillors commented on the fact that some businesses in the community were allowing rubbish to be blown away in the high winds.

Comments were also made that the bin men were not picking up waste that they dropped when collecting bins and that the new trolliblocs were not proving as successful as expected due to their limited capacity.

The Town Councillors acknowledge that the street cleaner in Conwy was doing a very good job but the incidences of people littering was increasing along with incidences of dog fouling **RESOLVED** that:

- a) representatives of Environment, Roads & Facilities, Conwy County Borough Council are invited to a future meeting to discuss the problems
- b) the Town Council looks at providing extra bins on Christmas Eve
- c) Town Councillors speak to shopkeepers to discuss what they can do to help

110 3rd Ouarter Accounts 2014/15

a) Councillors received the budget reports for the 3rd quarter ended 31st December 2014 (Schedules C to F)

The overall underspend for the year is expected to be just over £35k. This is due in the main to savings on utilities (£1.4k), Elections (£15k), Insurance (£3.3k), Salaries £16.7k), printing of the Town Guide (£1k), donations to Festivals (£1k), Translation Services (£4.3k). Overspends are expected on Donations (£3.7k) due to the grant made to Llandudno Junction Football Club and an accounting technicality, Mayoral Civic (£1k) due to renovation of the Cenotaph and replacement of the Mace Case, erection of notice boards in Conwy and Deganwy and the continued renewal of the electrical infrastructure for the Christmas lights.

The Town Clerk explained to Councillors that savings relating to specific projects would be taken to an Earmarked Reserve for that project unless it was not to go ahead at all, in which case it would go to General Reserves.

The Town Clerk expected Reserves to be around £160k at 31st March 2015. £66k relates to Earmarked Reserves and the remainder to General Reserves.

RESOLVED that the Budget Reports and Reserve Report for the quarter ended 31st December 2014 are approved

b) Councillors received the Bank Reconciliation & Financial Statement as at 31st December 2014 (Schedule G)

The balance at the Bank as at 31st December 2014 was £238,270.66 with £3,487.06 outstanding cheques, giving a closing balance of £234,783.60

RESOLVED that the Bank Reconciliation & Financial Statements as at 31st December 2014 are approved.

Councillors thanked the Town Clerk for her work on the accounts

111. Conwy Bronze

The Town Clerk informed Councillors that the Scrolls, which form part of the Conwy Bronze had been found at Bodlondeb. The County Council will keep one set, to go with the Bronze they have at Bodlondeb, but would like to donate the other set to the Town Council to go with the Bronze in the Guildhall. They would like to have a small ceremony to mark the handover of the Scrolls **RESOLVED** that the offer is accepted and that the Town Clerk speaks to Mr Finch about the handover
