2. Developments of National Significance

The Planning Wales Act 2015 introduced a new type of development, Developments of National Significance (DNS). Decisions on planning applications for Developments of National Significance will be made by the Welsh Government, not your local planning authority. The Planning Wales Act 2015 (Section 62Q) amended Schedule 1A of the Town & Country Planning Act 1990 to require Welsh Ministers to notify the Council for a community or group of communities of an application for a Development of National Significance in its area, if requested to do so. I am writing to give you the opportunity to register your request by simply pressing reply to this message. We will keep your request on record & you will be notified of any DNS application made in your area. As drafted, the regulations require a developer proposing a Development of National Significance to consult community councils before an application is made to Welsh Ministers. In addition, the Inspectorate will be publishing a procedure guide within which we will encourage developers to engage with local communities from the early stages of project development.
