a) Conwy History Tours 2019

b) The Distinguished Gentleman's Ride (DGR) 2019

Once again the worldwide charity motorcycle event "The Distinguished Gentlemen's Ride" (<http://www.gentlemansride.com>) is taking place on Sunday September 29th 2019, as in previous years (2014-18), we would like to ask your permission for the North Wales contingent to have a parking area set aside for approximately 100 motorcycles (we stress that this is an organised charity event with all riders self-insured on their own classically styled machines) at: •Rhyl Theatre car park - as an initial meeting point from 10:00am, leaving 11:00am •Abergele/Pensarn promenade public car park (by Pantri Bach Café) - regroup - approx 11:30-12pm •Porth Eirias public car park (far end) - regroup - approx 12:30-13:00pm •Llandudno promenade (approx opposite St George's Hotel) - regroup - approx 1:30-2:00pm. We believe that Wales Rally GB(?) may be setting up at our 'usual' gathering point (opp. St George's Hotel), do you wish us to use another area? •Use of the Marine Drive Toll road for a single block fee for the group to enable a free-flowing ride-out (please can you advise if the Marine Drive toll road is free of other events at that time of day?) •Conwy Harbour Master/Office Car Park - end point - approx 3:30pm. I'd be very grateful if you could let me know as soon as possible, if you have any questions please feel free to ask.
