

**MEETING OF THE TOWN COUNCIL****15<sup>th</sup> AUGUST 2016****TOWN CLERK'S REPORT****1. CCBC Public Footpath No 34 (part) in the Community of Conwy**

Notice of public path diversion order, Town & Country Planning Act 1990 section 257 CCBC. The above Order was made on 20/7/16 under Section 257 of the Town and Country Planning Act 1990. The effect of the Order will be to divert the following public footpath. That section of public footpath 34 in the community of Conwy commencing from a point just north of Sarn Mynach at grid reference SH 8056 7799 & proceeding in a north easterly direction through fields for approximately 310m to terminate at the junction with the Royal Welsh Way (A470)(T) at grid reference SH 8056 7833. to a new line commencing from a point just north of Sarn Mynach at grid reference SH 8056 7799 & proceeding northerly then north westerly for a short distance then proceeding in a north easterly direction through the proposed Development along a surfaced footway to terminate at the junction with the Royal Welsh Way (A470)(T) at grid reference SH 8056 7833. The length of the diverted route is approximately 355m. A copy of the Order & the Order plan may be examined at Conwy Library, Castle Street, Conwy, LL32 6AY & at the offices of the Head of Law & Governance, Bodlondeb, Conwy during normal opening/office hours. Any representations or objections to the Order must be sent in writing stating the grounds on which it is made to the Head of Law & Governance, Bodlondeb, Conwy, LL32 8DU not later than 25/8/16. If no representations or objections are duly made, or if any so made are withdrawn, the Conwy County Borough Council may confirm the Order as an unopposed Order. If the Order is sent to the Welsh Ministers for confirmation, any representations & objections which have not been withdrawn will be sent with the Order. **5. Courses/Workshops/Training/Conferences****a) Recruitment of Additional Training Associate**

One Voice Wales now offers some 21 training modules as part of its Councillor training programme & with training delivery requirements likely to increase substantially after the May 2017 elections we are looking to recruit a number of additional training associates. In particular, we are looking for trainers to deliver modules in the Carmarthenshire & Pembrokeshire area; deliver modules in the Ceredigion & Southern Gwynedd area; an additional trainer in the North Wales area & an additional trainer in the South Wales area. Although not essential, it is highly desirable that some of the new trainers are bilingual.

Training Associates appointed to these roles will be required to enter into an Associate Agreement, will be expected to attend a Train the Trainer event in Mid Wales (expenses will be paid) & will be provided with a trainer's kit to enable them to deliver the modules. Associates do not receive a salary but are paid for each training module delivered. Currently the training associate rate is £10 per hour for travel time to and from venues, £35 per hour

for a three hour training course & a mileage rate of 45 pence per mile. There is no guarantee of any work & training delivered depends on the demand for courses offered in our training programme. If you are interested in being considered for a Training Associate role, I would be grateful if you could send me your CV together with the name of two referees who can be approached for a reference. In addition you are invited to supply a 200 word statement giving your reasons as to why you would like to become a Training Associate.
