**3. Early Engagement Drop-in Session - Deganwy Area**

As part of our 21st Century Band B Programme, we are carrying out Early Engagement sessions with stakeholders of the Deganwy area. We are looking to gather information/views/thoughts of those in the locality with reference to how we can develop our Educational assets in the catchment area. **4. Dŵr Cymru Welsh Water**

Over the next few months Welsh Water will be investing more than £1.1 million on improving the wastewater network in Llandudno Junction to protect properties in the area from flooding from the network. Why are we doing the work? Sewers in the Llandudno Junction area are combined sewers, which means that wastewater from kitchens and toilets are carried by the same sewers as roof rainwater. During heavy rainfall this can sometimes overwhelm the system which can cause water to escape from manholes causing flooding. To create more room in the network to stop flooding, we will be putting in a new sewer. Following investigation work in September, we are now ready to carry out the work. Thank you to everyone that attended our information event before Christmas. If you were not able to attend the event, here you'll find more information about the work we'll be carrying out in your area. How we are doing it? To stop flooding from the network we will be putting in a new sewer pipe along Kimberly Road up to the carpark of Preswylfa Chapel and then on to Conwy Road, from the Junction with Avallon Avenue to Queens Road. So that our contractors can work safely, we will need to close these roads for a period of time. We will start working in the area on Monday, January 14th. The first thing we will be doing is widening the entrance to Osborne carpark so that cars will then be accessing and exiting the carpark from Conwy Road. This work will take us a couple of weeks but while we carry out this work Osborne carpark will be open as usual. We will then be working on Kimberly Road from the bottom to the top. So that our contractors can work safely and quickly, Kimberly Road will be closed to traffic from January 23rd. As we will be working on the junction between Osborne Terrace and Kimberly Road, there will be no access to through traffic. Residents will be able to access Osborne Terrace through Osborne carpark. For most of this work, we will be drilling in the ground to put in the new sewer to minimise disruption to residents. The work in Kimberly Road and on the junction with Osborne Terrace should be finished by mid-March, but we will do our best to finish sooner. During this time, The Maelgwyn pub will be open as usual. After we finish this section, we will then be working on a section of Conwy Road between the junction with Queen's Road and Avallon Road. We will be working on this section from mid-March until mid-May, but again we will do our best to finish as soon as we can. While we are working on this section of Conwy Road, access to side streets will be via a local diversion and Conwy Road via the A55. We will make sure that there will be plenty of signs up to let motorists know. All businesses along the Conwy Road as well as Osborne carpark will be open as usual while we carry out the work. If you are a business on Conwy Road that

is affected, you are welcome to get in touch with us if you have any queries or if you would like us to visit you with more information. The Team. This work will be carried out by our partners Morgan Sindall and their contractor Active Tunnelling, so you may well notice their vehicles in the area during this time. They will be working on Monday to Friday, 7.30am until 5.30pm (3pm on Fridays), although they may need to work later or on weekends to get the work done. If you have any questions about the work or would like more information, the team on site will be happy to answer any questions you may have about the work, or you are welcome to get in touch with us. We understand that our work can be inconvenient and we would like to thank you in advance for bearing with us while this essential work takes place.
